*A chord “happens” when a group of notes is played at the same time - strumming. When those same notes are played one by one, it is called an arpeggio “AR-Pay-Gee-Oh” These are called “lenthwise arpeggios” because all the notes are played on the same string making it easy to play them fast with proper technique. Refer to the video!

Arpeggios sound great when played over their corresponding chords such as in the ending solo in Hotel California by The Eagles and the ending of Sultans Of Swing by The Dire Straits, along with loads of metal solos like in Van Halen, Pantera, and Avenged 7 Fold to name a few...
